Returning to Campus Directions

On site worship at GUMC resumes June 13 and 14. Each service will be live streamed through the church website or YouTube and will be recorded for viewing on the church website at alternate times.

- Masks are always required when one is in any GUMC Building. For worship (Saturday evening and Sunday morning, see below) the doors at the Welcome Center (West Street side), North (Germantown Road side) Entrance and Education Wing entrance will be open. Please bring the mask you have been using, one with which you are comfortable.
- Anyone who does not have a mask will be given one to wear while in any GUMC building. Masks and hand sanitizer are available at the three major entrances to the main campus, mentioned above along with posters giving instructions on safety protocols. TAKE YOUR MASK AWAY WITH YOU.
- Social distancing of six-feet spaces will be indicated and directed.
- All services will be in the sanctuary. The main floor and balcony will be open.
- Overflow seating will be in the Mike Wilson Fellowship Hall and the OLEC gym.
- Phased returns indicate that initially we might be able to have no more than:
 - · 72 worshippers in the sanctuary (floor and balcony together)
 - · 25 in the Mike Wilson Fellowship Hall
 - · 80 in the OLEC gym
- Please make your plans accordingly and consider sitting in the balcony or Fellowship Hall if you do not want to be seen entering late.
- Saturday, June 13 5:00 p.m. will be our Ancient-Modern worship service.
- Sunday, June 14 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. will be our Traditional worship services.
- Entrance to the Sanctuary will ONLY be through the doors in the East side Hallway near the "front" of the church.
- Worshippers will enter through the double doors and walk to the back of the sanctuary to take their seats as directed by the ushers. Please maintain social distance as you wait to enter.
- Seating will be on every other pew only. Six-foot spaces will be marked on each pew to help individual worshippers be safe.
- Family units or people who have guarantined together may sit together.
- At the end of each service, worshippers will be directed to EXIT ONLY through the Narthex doors, one pew at a time.
- Nothing will be passed among worshippers. Bulletins will be in the pew racks before each service. Please take your bulletin when you leave. Bulletins remaining in the pews after service will be removed.
- Individual attendance cards will be in the pews before each service. Cards remaining in the pews after service will be removed. Please place your filled in card in the Offering plate in the Narthex as you leave.
- The Children's Ministry will provide "Worship Activity Bags" on the side table as you enter any worship space. Please take one per child as you enter the sanctuary. Please take the bag and contents home with you after service.
- Offerings always may be made online through GUMC's regular online facilities.
- Offerings may also be placed in offering plates on tables in the Narthex.
- Attendance cards may be placed in the plates as well.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

No classes (Adult, Youth, Child, or Nursery) will meet in campus buildings until after the Germantown Municipal School District deems the environment is safe for children and adults to return to class. Even then we may wait two weeks or more to assess the situation.

Other Scholarships

- · Once registered, training logs and more information will be emailed to you.

HOW TO EARN POINTS FOR YOUR CHURCH TEAM: (SAMPLE)

· Individuals earn weekly points for your team for each minute of exercise up to a maximum of 250 minutes/points per person. Any form of exercise will count: walk, run, bike, dance, row, elliptical, yoga, tai chi, Pilates, Zumba, strength training, tennis, golf, etc.

Example:

o Monday: Zoom, Walked, or ran 30 minutes 30 points

o Tuesday: Biked for 40 minutes/10 minute core workout 50 points

o Wednesday: Yoga class 45 minutes 45 points

o Thursday: Danced – 30 minutes 30 points

o Friday: Walked or ran 45 minutes 45 points

o Saturday: Strength workout 30 points = 230/wk
